



RES is exploring the potential for a wind farm of up to 10 turbines at Cairnmore Hill, approximately 4.5km west of Scrabster on the north coast of Caithness.

We are keen to engage with the local community and as part of our pre-application consultation we are holding public exhibitions in the local area to enable people to find out more about the proposal and provide us with their views. RES staff will be on hand to answer any questions or queries, and questionnaires will be available to gather feedback.

The exhibitions initiate a consultation period being run by RES to gather comments on the proposal. **The closing date for comments is Friday 23 December, 2016.** Comments after this date will still be accepted but not necessarily considered in relation to the development of the proposal.
